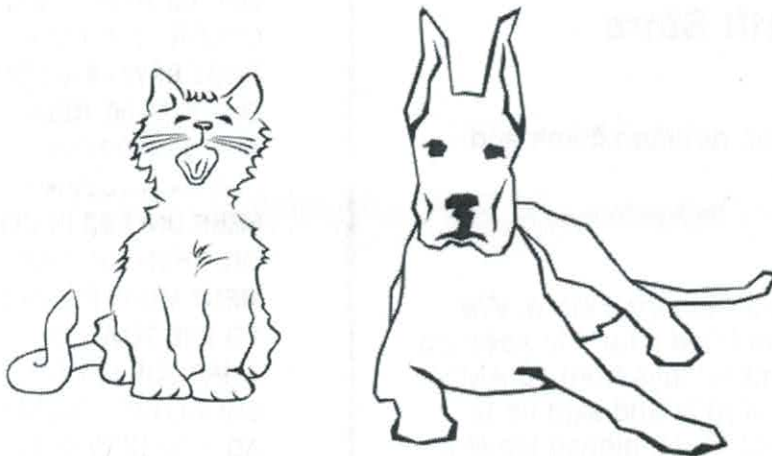
Attention residents who are in need of assistance obtaining cat & dog food.

If you are interested in the program you must fill out an application in advance.

In addition, in order for your pet to qualify they must be spayed or neutered. If your pet is not spayed or neutered PAL also has a low cost program.

OPEN BURN POLICY AMARGOSA VALLEY

The Amargosa Fire Department allows residents to conduct open burning of vegetation and weeds on their property from Nov 1 thru May 31. The burn period operates from sunrise to sunset. To get approval, contact Nye County Dispatch @ 775-372-5345 (press 5 for non-emergency). The AFD may send a member to your location to observe if deemed necessary.

Only burn on a calm day.

Have a 20-foot open radius around the burn site.

Have a hose ready in case the fire spreads.

ANY UNAPPROVED OPEN BURN THAT REQUIRES ASSISTANCE FROM THE AFD MAY RESULT IN THE RESIDENT BEING HELD FINANCIALLY RESPONSIBLE.

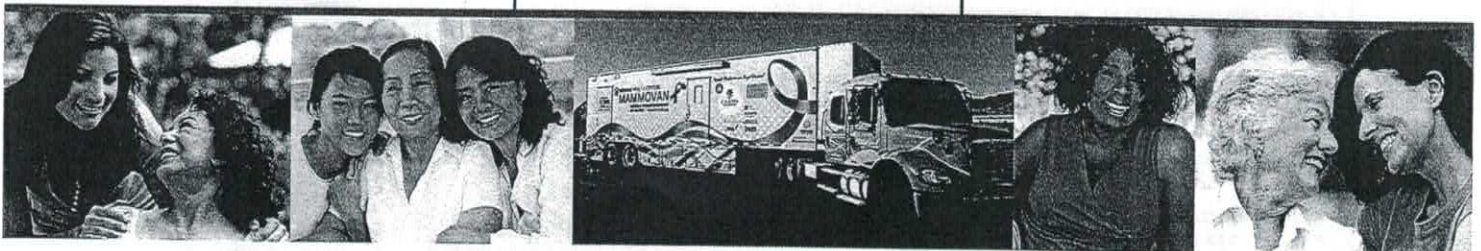
- Women 40 and over require NO referral. Women 39 and under, or men, MUST present a physician (PCP) referral
- Must be at least 366 days since last screening
- NO minors can be left unattended and they may NOT accompany you into the exam room
- Results are mailed directly to you and your PCP / Specialist

Please be sure you have all of the following with you upon arrival to ensure a smooth check in experience:

- Current & valid government issued photo ID
- Current insurance card (if applicable)
- Completed registration forms (available online at nvhealthcenters.org/services/mammovan)
- Name & phone number of your Primary Care Physician (PCP)

Acceptable Methods of Payment:

- Medicare • Medicaid • Sliding Fee Scale
- Women's Health Connection (WHC)
- Most major insurances - Yearly Preventive Screenings are covered under most insurances, however, verify your coverage prior to your appointment to assure the Mammovan is an accepted provider.
- Individuals **NOT COVERED** by health insurance may qualify for a "no charge" screening.
