The National Weather Service rain gauge at Furnace Creek measured 2.2 inches of rain on August 20, 2023. This exceeds the park’s annual average rainfall of 2.15 inches. This set a new single-day rainfall record for Death Valley, breaking the previous record of 1.70 inches set on August 5, 2022. The National Weather Service radar indicates some parts of the park may have received around 5 inches of rain that day. This unprecedented rainfall was due to the remnants of Hurricane Hilary.

All paved and unpaved roads in Death Valley have been damaged and are closed. Undercutting of pavement and pavement loss make travel conditions unsafe. Additionally four utility systems were compromised by debris that moved during the flash flooding, dislodging water and wastewater pipes and impacting a well. The full extent of the damage across the park will not be known for a period of weeks, as roads make overland travel challenging in order for park crews to identify additional storm damage impacts, however aerial surveys indicated extensive parkwide flooding impacts.

Park officials say the park will likely reopen in stages. It may be weeks before Furnace Creek and Stovepipe Wells open. Secondary roads in the park may take months to open. Utility systems also need to be stabilized prior to reopening.

El pluviómetro del Servicio Meteorológico Nacional en Furnace Creek midió 2.2 pulgadas de lluvia el 20 de agosto de 2023. Esto excede la precipitación promedio anual del parque de 2.15 pulgadas. Esto estableció un nuevo récord de precipitaciones en un solo día para el Valle de la Muerte, rompiendo el récord anterior de 1.70 pulgadas establecido el 5 de agosto de 2022. El radar del Servicio Meteorológico Nacional indica que algunas partes del parque pueden haber recibido alrededor de 5 pulgadas de lluvia ese día. Esta lluvia sin precedentes se debió a los restos del huracán Hilary.

Todas las carreteras pavimentadas y sin pavimentar del Valle de la Muerte han resultado dañadas y están cerradas. El socavamiento del pavimento y la pérdida del pavimento hacen que las condiciones de viaje sean inseguras. Además, cuatro sistemas de servicios públicos se vieron comprometidos por escombros que se movieron durante la inundación repentina, desalojando tuberías de agua y aguas residuales e impactando un pozo. El alcance total de los daños en todo el parque no se conocerá hasta dentro de un periodo de semanas, ya que las carreteras dificultan los viajes por tierra para que los equipos del parque identifiquen los impactos adicionales de los daños de la tormenta; sin embargo, los estudios aéreos indicaron extensos impactos de inundaciones en todo el parque.

Los funcionarios del parque dicen que el parque probablemente reabrirá en etapas. Pueden pasar semanas antes de que abran Furnace Creek y Stovepipe Wells. Las carreteras secundarias del parque pueden tardar meses en abrirse. Los sistemas de servicios públicos también deben estabilizarse antes de la reapertura.
