- Dave Hall We used to do a soft billing when I was with the fire department in Ohio. We would send the bill to the insurance company.
- John Bosta There was supposed to be a park built at the Dunes. It was a project between BLM and Nye County. We do not have an agreement with BLM. TV Crews have used the Dunes before.
