## FIRE DEPARTMENT

Last year, the Fire Department responded to 137 calls including mutual aid to Beatty Vol. Fire Department and Southern Inyo Fire District, CA. We train on average two – three days a month, on Tuesday nights and Saturday. The Fire Department also hosts a State Certification class. Departments that have trained here are Pahrump Valley Fire & Rescue volunteers and Southern Inyo Fire District volunteers. In May, we will host joint fire training with departments from Utah and Nevada National Security Site Fire & Rescue. All training is based on what our valley needs and how we can protect those living here and traveling on our local roads.

The next big step we are taking on is the Ambulance Service. This service is needed so we can respond locally for medical emergencies. For the past few years, we have had to rely on mutual aid ambulances for transportation. With that, the wait time is extremely long and in the past year we had 5 volunteers trained as Emergency Medical Responders. With training our volunteers, we're able to provide some



assistance while waiting for the ambulance. With us operating the ambulance service, we could treat the problem and be transporting in less time than it takes for mutual aid to arrive. At this time, we have 8 volunteers taking EMT training so we can better support our community. If you don't want to be an EMT, we can always use drivers.

We are starting a Cadet Firefighter program for our youth here in the valley. Any male or female ages 16-17 can join and can participate in training and other activities. The youth of this valley are the future of the department and we need you. Stop in and get information and take a tour of the station.

I expect this department to be called on for more mutual aid responses and our call volume to increase. All the training I've mentioned is free and so is the equipment. We need more **VOLUNTEERS** to meet the challenge ahead. Join

the Fire Department, get some great training, and help protect your family, neighbors, and the valley.

### The Minimal Facts about the Resurrection of Jesus

The resurrection of Jesus sets Christianity apart from all other religions. Without the resurrection, there is no Christian faith. As the Apostle Paul said in I Corinthians 15:17: "And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins." While there are many different ways Christians have argued for the resurrection of Christ, I would like to present to you what is known as the "minimal facts" approach. There are certain facts about the rise of Christianity that even non-Christians agree on.

The vast majority of scholars of history (whether Christian or not) agree on the following events:

1. Jesus died by crucifixion under Pontius Pilate.

2. Jesus' tomb was empty and no body could be found.
3. The original disciples of Jesus claimed that he appeared to them after being raised from the dead.
4. The skeptic James came to believe that Jesus had been raised from the dead.
5. The persecutor Paul came to believe that Jesus had been raised from the dead.
6. The Christian faith spread in the midst of persecution.
7. The original disciples of Jesus were willing to die for what they knew was either the truth or a lie.
8. The Apostles Peter, Paul, and James all died as martyrs for their faith.

The reason why these events are so certain is because they can be found in both Christian and non-Christian historical sources such as the writings of Tacitus, Suetonius, Josephus, Lucian, the Jewish Talmud, Eusebius of Caesarea, Clement of Rome, Polycarp, and Tertullian.

Given these facts, what explanation best accounts for all the evidence? The most straightforward answer is that Jesus was truly raised from the dead fulfilling the Old Testament prophecy of Isaiah 53 and many others. If Jesus was raised from the dead, then he is the one he claimed to be and he claimed to be God in the flesh and that eternal life only comes through faith in him (John 8:58; 14:6). You can explore this evidence further in the book *The Case for the Resurrection of Jesus* by Gary Habermas and Michael Licona.

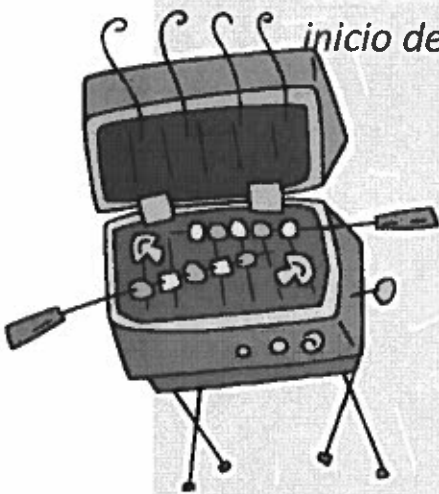

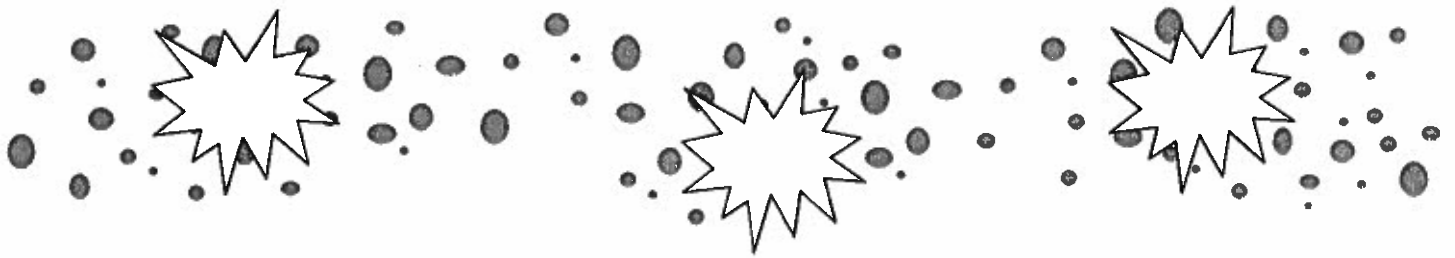
