**DEATH VALLEY, Calif.** – Park rangers are reminding the public not to touch, handle, or feed wildlife. Two recent incidents at Death Valley National Park show the risks to human and wildlife from these interactions: a woman was bitten by a bat with rabies and a coyote was struck by a car.

### **Bat with rabies**

On April 28, a bat was seen behaving strangely. It was sitting on top of a garbage can outside the Stovepipe Wells general store. A concession employee moved the bat away from the public space. The bat bit her through her nitrile gloves. National Park Service employees collected the bat, and California Department of Public Health tested it for rabies. On May 2, the woman was informed that the bat did have rabies. She is being treated for rabies exposure.

Anyone who may have had contact with this bat should contact Inyo County Health Department at 760-873-7868 for medical guidance.

Rabies is usually fatal, unless treated before symptoms begin. Humans can get rabies through contact with an infected animal's saliva, such as a bite or scratch. Any mammal can carry rabies. People should be especially concerned when an animal is behaving aggressively or does not show a normal fear of humans.

Bats are an important part of the ecosystem. At least nine species of insect-eating bats live in Death Valley National Park. Typically, less than 1% of bats have rabies. Bats—and all other native wildlife—are protected within the park.

### **Coyote struck by vehicle**

A week earlier a coyote was struck by a vehicle on CA-190 near the intersection with Badwater Road. The coyote limped away, and it is not known if it survived. Some coyotes in the park have learned to associate vehicles with people feeding them, which is illegal in the national park. Habituated coyotes have learned that they can stop traffic by walking in front of moving vehicles.

### **How to stay safe around wildlife**

- Never approach, touch, feed, or pick up a wild animal. Please enjoy wildlife from a safe distance.
- If you see sick, dead, or erratic behaving wildlife in the park, notify a park employee.
- Consult with your doctor in the event you have contacted an animal thought to be rabid.
- In areas where pets are allowed, make sure that pets are always vaccinated and kept on a leash.
- Stay out of mine openings and other places bats are likely to roost.

DEATH VALLEY, Calif. – Los guardaparques le recuerdan al público que no toque, manipule ni alimente a la vida silvestre. Dos incidentes recientes en el Parque Nacional Death Valley muestran los riesgos para los humanos y la vida silvestre de estas interacciones: una mujer fue mordida por un murciélago con rabia y un coyote fue atropellado por un automóvil.

### Murciélago con rabia

El 28 de abril, se vio a un murciélago comportándose de manera extraña. Estaba encima de un bote de basura fuera de la tienda general de Stovepipe Wells. Un empleado de la concesión alejó el bate del espacio público. El murciélago la mordió a través de sus guantes de nitrilo. Los empleados del Servicio de Parques Nacionales recolectaron el murciélago y el Departamento de Salud Pública de California lo analizó para detectar rabia. El 2 de mayo le informaron a la mujer que el murciélago sí tenía rabia. Ella está siendo tratada por exposición a la rabia.

Cualquiera que haya tenido contacto con este murciélago debe comunicarse con el Departamento de Salud del Condado de Inyo al 760-873-7868 para recibir orientación médica.

La rabia suele ser fatal, a menos que se trate antes de que comiencen los síntomas. Los seres humanos pueden contraer la rabia a través del contacto con la saliva de un animal infectado, como una mordedura o un arañazo. Cualquier mamífero puede portar la rabia. Las personas deben preocuparse especialmente cuando un animal se comporta agresivamente o no muestra un miedo normal a los humanos.

Los murciélagos son una parte importante del ecosistema. Al menos nueve especies de murciélagos comedores de insectos viven en el Parque Nacional Death Valley. Por lo general, menos del 1% de los murciélagos tienen rabia. Los murciélagos, y todos los demás animales salvajes nativos, están protegidos dentro del parque.

### Coyote atropellado por vehículo

Una semana antes, un coyote fue atropellado por un vehículo en CA-190 cerca de la intersección con Badwater Road. El coyote se alejó cojeando y no se sabe si sobrevivió. Algunos coyotes en el parque han aprendido a asociar vehículos con personas que los alimentan, lo cual es ilegal en el parque nacional. Los coyotes habituados han aprendido que pueden detener el tráfico caminando frente a los vehículos en movimiento.

### Cómo mantenerse a salvo alrededor de la vida silvestre

- Nunca se acerque, toque, alimente o recoja un animal salvaje. Disfrute de la vida silvestre desde una distancia segura.
- Si ve animales salvajes enfermos, muertos o de comportamiento errático en el parque, notifique a un empleado del parque.
- Consulte con su médico en caso de que haya estado en contacto con un animal que se cree que tiene rabia.
- En áreas donde se permiten mascotas, asegúrese de que las mascotas estén siempre vacunadas y con correa.
- Manténgase alejado de las aberturas de las minas y otros lugares donde los murciélagos puedan anidar.
