AMARGOSA DAYS APRIL 28-29

Valley Electric will be starting a PCA charge on our bills May 1st. This will allow them to recover the loses they experienced during the price spike in December. It will take 12 months at 1.4 cents per kilowatt to balance out. This will also allow them to adjust if acquiring power costs go up.

Nye County has reopened applications for the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Small Business Grant Program, adding Premium Incentive Pay Program applications.

For Fiscal Year 2023, Nye County has \$680,000 in ARPA funds to assist local **Small Businesses** adversely impacted by the COVID-19 public health emergency. Grant Awards have been made available for small business and nonprofit applicants with fewer than 30 employees who are independently owned and operated.

Tomará 12 meses a 1,4 centavos por kilovatio para equilibrarse. Esto también les permitirá adaptarse si aumentan los costos de adquisición de energía.
